Prairie chickens; open seasons, bag limits, and possession limits; permit. PROPOSED AMENDMENT

As a result of internal Department and public comment on the proposed regulation, the Department offers that the following amendment to the version of the regulation submitted for public comment.

K.A.R. 115-25-1. Prairie chickens; open seasons, bag limits, and possession limits; permit.

1. Amend proposed subsections (b) and (c) as follows:

- (b) Southwest unit. The open season for the taking of prairie chickens shall be the third Saturday in November through December 31, in that part of Kansas bounded by a line from the Colorado-Kansas state line east on interstate highway I-70 state highway K-96 to its junction with federal highway US-56, then east on federal highway US-56 to its junction with federal highway US-281, then south on federal highway US-281 to its junction with the Oklahoma-Kansas state line, then west along the Oklahoma-Kansas state line to its junction with the Colorado-Kansas state line, and then north along the Colorado-Kansas state line to its junction with interstate highway I-70.
- (c) Northwest unit. The open season for the taking of prairie chickens shall be September 15 through October 15 and shall reopen on the third Saturday of November through January 31 of the following year, in that part of Kansas bounded by a line from the Colorado-Kansas state line east on interstate highway I-70 state highway K-96 to its junction with federal highway US-56, then east on federal highway US-56 to its junction with federal highway US-281, then north on federal highway US-281 to its junction with the Nebraska-Kansas state line, then west along the Nebraska-Kansas state line to its junction with the Colorado-Kansas state line, and then south along the Colorado-Kansas state line to its junction with interstate highway I-70.
